

Large commercial development project under construction on Industrial Boulevard

VICTORVILLE — Construction has begun on a large commercial development project along a busy roadway near Bear Valley Road.

Joseph W. Brady, the president of The Bradco Companies, told the Daily Press a large flex-space commercial building is currently under construction on 5-acres along Industrial Boulevard in Victorville.

Brady said his company sold the two-parcel property to Richard Gottlieb, the managing member of Bedford Industrial who is currently working on the first phase of the two-phase project.

Phase one includes a 14,234-square-foot building that will include four units. This building is currently in the foundation stage and will be situated on the east side of the property.

The phase two building will consist of nearly 13,000 square feet and will be divided into six units. This building will be situation on the west of the property, nearer to Industrial Boulevard, according to a report from the City of Victorville.

The project, which will sit adjacent to the Sherwin-Williams property, should be completed by October, Brady said.
