## **CSD for Spring Valley Lake?**

Spring Valley Lake is the oldest master planned community in the entire High Desert region.

For the first time in many decades, Spring Valley Lake, its Association staff and board of directors has created an excellent working relationship with senior San Bernardino County officials and the supervisors. If Spring Valley Lake is to continue to grow, money needs to be spent to maintain it. The question is who pays, how do we pay and what is the most fair way to allocate costs?

While annexation to the town of Apple Valley might be one of many possibilities, so may be the creation of a Community Service District (CSD). I believe our Spring Valley Lake board will investigate all questions from home owners, and will provide us options for our association after their meetings.

Change is inevitable. No matter what, Spring Valley Lake is the High Desert's largest community — 4,213 lots, nearly 91 percent built-out with nearly 4,058 registered voters, 12,000 estimated residents and an asset value of nearly \$1 billion.

If we are going to grow and hopefully increase our property values, we need to work together.
